



Common Human Resource Information Standards

Organization Position Identifier

Organization Position Identifier is the alias for an Organization Unique Identifier (OUID) used within an organization to identify a specific authorized position.

Permitted Values

- Reference Element: Air Force Position Number
- Reference Element: Army Position Number (POSNO)
- Reference Element: Marine Corps Billet Identification Code (BIC)
- Reference Element: Navy Billet Sequence Code (BSC)

Structural Business Rules

A Member Military Position Identifier must have an associated Military Position Identifier.

A Military Position Identifier must have only one associated Military Position Name.

A Military Position Identifier must have only one associated Position Unique Identifier.

A DoD Military Service member inherits a Military Position Name through an association between the Member Military Position Identifier and the Military Position Identifier.

A Military Position Identifier must have an associated Military Unit Identifier when designating the composition of billets authorized for a military unit.
